Artistic Expressions Scholarship and Registration Form

Thanks to generous donations, the Hunterdon Art Museum has created a scholarship fund for adults with developmental disabilities who would like to take an art class. The Museum's class for adults with developmental disabilities, Artistic Expressions, is designed for individuals to experiment with many forms of art making at their own pace and skill level. Two instructors and a maximum class size of ten students means each student receives individualized attention. Class mediums include, but are not limited to painting, drawing, clay, weaving, woodworking, and printmaking. Lead teacher Jim Pruznick has taught Artistic Expressions for 25 years.

• **Location & Facility:** Classes are held in the Museum's studios. The Museum and its studios are ADA compliant. Each class size is restricted to 10 students maximum to allow for each student to have enough room to work comfortably and receive individualized attention. There is a total of 20 spots in class available, 10 on Tuesday and 10 on Thursday.

• **Enrollment & Availability:** Full Scholarships are available on a first come, first serve basis. Spring applications are due by Tuesday, April 11. There are a total of 10 scholarships

available for the Spring Semester. The first 10 individuals to apply will receive full tuition for either the Tuesday or Thursday class. Additional spots will be available in classes at the normal tuition rate:

Spring Semester:
\$60 each for 6 week session
