Scholarship and Registration Form: “Artistic Expressions”

Thanks to generous underwriting from Janssen Pharmaceuticals, the Hunterdon Art Museum has created a scholarship fund for people with special needs who would like to take art class. We offer two classes: an adult as well as “Artistic Expressions,” a class for adults. Both classes are designed for people special needs, physical limitations and/or developmental disabilities. Classes are created for individuals to experiment with many forms of art making at their own pace and skill level. Class mediums include, but are not limited to painting, drawing, clay, weaving, woodworking, and printmaking. Class sizes are small and each student receives individualized attention.

• **Enrollment & Availability:** Full Scholarships are available on a first come, first-served basis. Winter applications are due by **Tuesday, January 7, 2020.**

There are a total of 10 full scholarships available for the winter Artistic Expressions class. Additional spots will be available in classes at the normal tuition rate.

• **Location & Facility:** Classes are held in the Museum’s studios. The Museum and its studios are ADA compliant

• **Attendance:** All students must sign in at the front desk of the Museum with the receptionist, to ensure accurate attendance.
