

Hunterdon Art Museum Summer 2020 Virtual Art Camps

Although our museum studios are closed this summer, we are still bringing art and learning to your family with **online summer programs** for kids and teens. Our summer art camps are now taking place online using [Zoom](#), which is a free platform. Zoom is accessible via all operating systems and devices with a microphone and camera. You can access it through your desktop, laptop, tablet, or phone.

Refund Policy

If you have already registered your child for HAM's on-site summer camp you may transfer that registration to the virtual camp. It's important to note, however, that our virtual camps are shorter and their tuition is less than the regular camp pricing.* A partial refund or a credit towards 2021 camps and classes for the difference in price may be requested by filling out the Camp Change Request Form. If virtual camps do not work for you, please complete the [Camp Change Request Form](#) to receive a full refund in the form of a check.

We will be issuing full refunds for tuition paid towards "Lunch with the Bunch" and "After Care," though the tuition may also be applied towards additional online programming or the online registration account to be used towards for future programming. All credit applied to your account will be usable through June 30, 2021, and can be used for registration in classes and workshops for kids and adults, 2021 summer camps, and Museum memberships.

Virtual Camp Changes & Refund Policy

Schedule Changes: All changes to camp registration must be requested at least 14 days before the start of the camp. If less than 14 days a \$25 processing fee will be charged.

Withdrawals: Withdrawals must be requested at least 14 days before the beginning of the camp. No refunds will be granted for cancellations less than two weeks prior to the start of a camp. If HAM cancels camp, a full refund will be given, otherwise, there will be NO refund or credit after a class begins.

If withdrawing from camp 14 days or more prior to the start of camp, there are three options:

- 1) 100% tuition may be credited to account for future payment on future classes and camps, valid through June 30, 2021. No processing fee will be charged.
- 2) A check in the amount of your tuition payment less a 20% processing fee can be sent to you.
- 3) You may make a tax-deductible donation to the Museum of any amount. If donating a portion, the remainder of your refund will be sent to you via check.

No refunds will be granted for cancellation less than two weeks before the beginning of camp. Refunds will not be granted for scheduling conflicts, no-shows, or to campers who leave or do not attend the camp of their own volition. Students missing classes by their own decision or withdrawing after classes begin will not receive a refund, credit, or make-up day.

Exceptions:

- If a camper is in a camp with a waiting list and another camper can take their seat, a refund may be possible minus the 20% processing fee.

- Campers who become ill for two or more consecutive days may request consideration for a prorated refund for that week of camp (a doctor's certification may be required).

Behavioral Policy: Please be advised that in cases of non-compliant behaviors, the Museum reserves the right to remove a student from class. To ensure a positive, productive, and pleasant camp experience it is important that all campers and parents/guardians follow behavioral guidelines:

- Always be respectful and polite towards the HAM instructor and other campers.
- Campers must use the email account provided at registration to log into Zoom.
- Meeting IDs must not be shared. Sharing of login information violates other campers' and teachers' rights to confidentiality, and could allow camp participation by unauthorized persons.

Materials & Clothing

Art supplies for the camp must be picked up at the Hunterdon Art Museum the Friday before the camp session starts. We will be instituting curbside pick-up for supplies.

Some camps require basic supplies from home; these materials are listed on the camp page on our website. Please review this prior to the start of the camp; reminders will be sent out the week prior to the start of the camp.

Art camp may get messy; please dress for a mess and be ready to have artful fun.
